## **Amateur Photography Rules:**

- 1. Prints must be 8x10 and must be mounted on an 11x14 matte board. No glass or frames. Any print not meeting this criteria will NOT be judged.
- 2. Only amateur and semi-professional photographers (anyone earning \$400 or less annually selling photography work is considered a semi-professional photographer.)
- 3. Entries will be divided into two divisions based on age of the photographer for Judging. (Youth- Under 18; Adult -18 and over)
- 4. All entries MUST be the work of the photographer entering.
- 5. Entries will be judged on merit.
- 6. Each entry must be identified on back with photographer's name, address & class.
- 7. Please be sure to read the additional rules printed in the front of the fair book.
- 8. One Best of Show ribbon will be awarded for youth division & one Best of Show will be awarded for adult division.
