1. Exhibits without minimum numbers or amounts will be ineligible for premiums but may be displayed.
2. EXHIBITS MUST BE PRESENT TO ENTER OWN EXHIBITS.
3. Exhibitors will be judged as two separate divisions – Junior up to age 18 and Senior over age of 18. (see additional rules for Section J)
4. Exhibits must be displayed while fair in session.
5. No more than one entry per class, per individual will be accepted.
6. Market Baskets may be picked up with a claim ticket.
7. In order to collect premium for an exhibit, each person, regardless of age, must have a valid season pass. The season pass must be presented when entering exhibits.

TIP: Success displays will be uniform in size, shape and color.
